



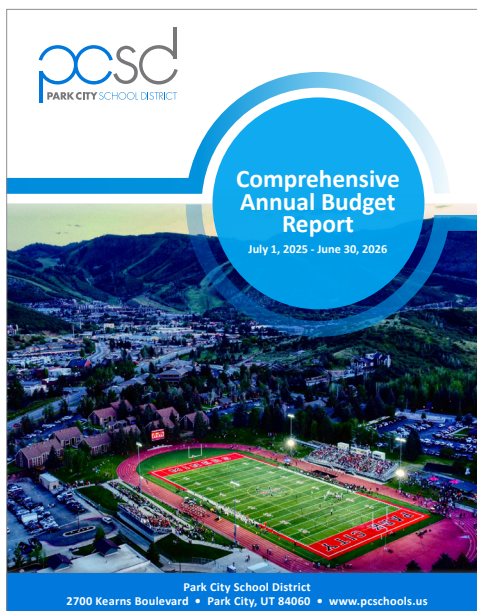

# Park City School District Modernizes Budget Management with Gravity

## THE NEED

Park City School District had been struggling with manual processes for creating and maintaining their budget book, a critical document for both internal planning and public transparency. Key challenges included:

- **Manual, Time-Consuming Processes:**  
The district relied on Word and Excel to compile their budget book, resulting in a labor-intensive process prone to errors and inefficiencies. The process was so cumbersome that it could take up to 25 minutes just to open the budget file due to its size and complexity.

- **Limited Staff Resources:**
